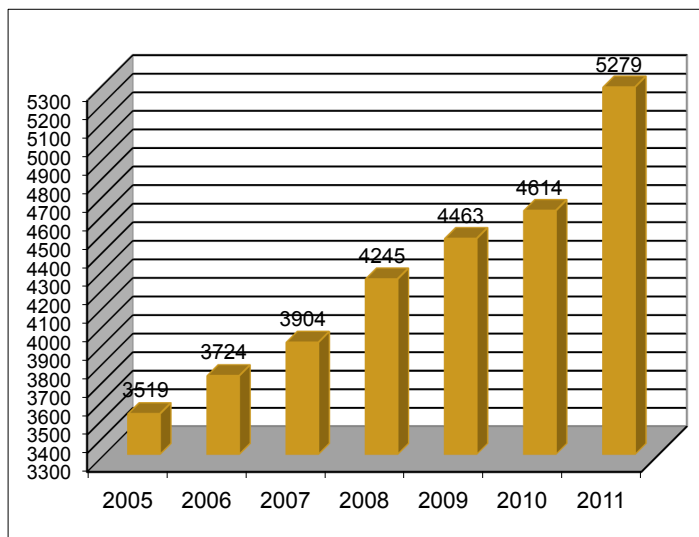

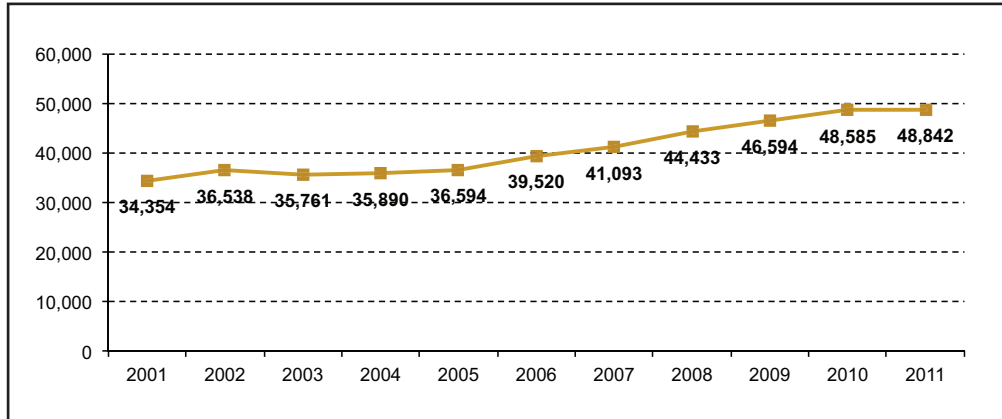

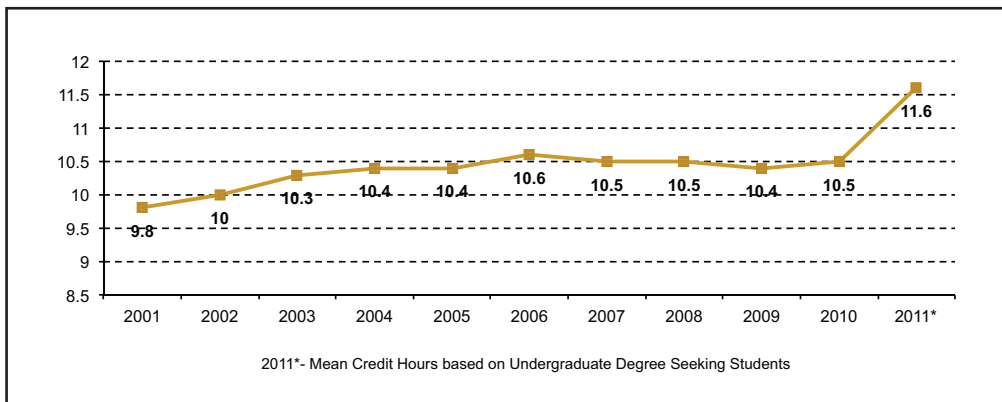

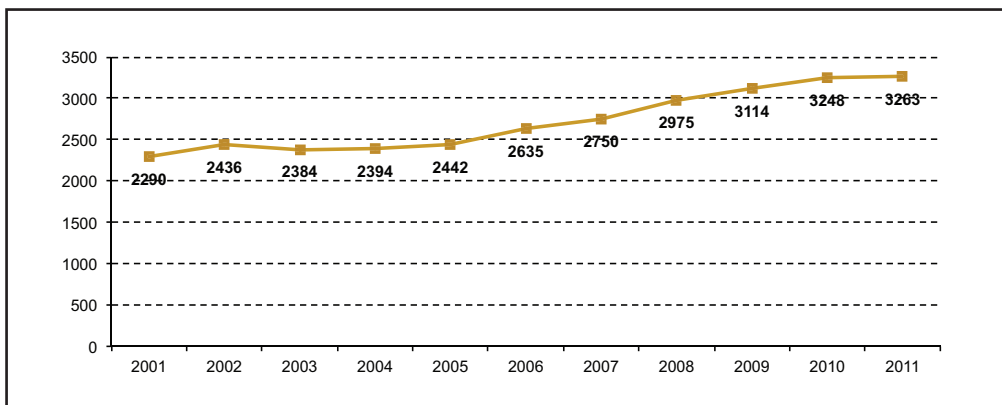
Total Credit Hours 2010-2011

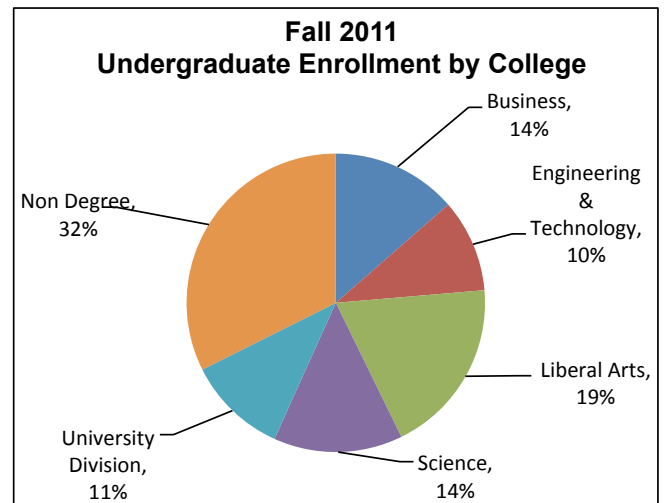
