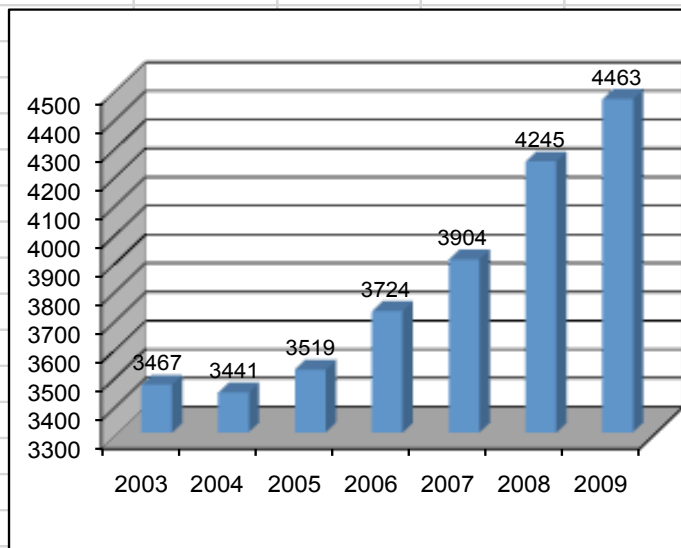

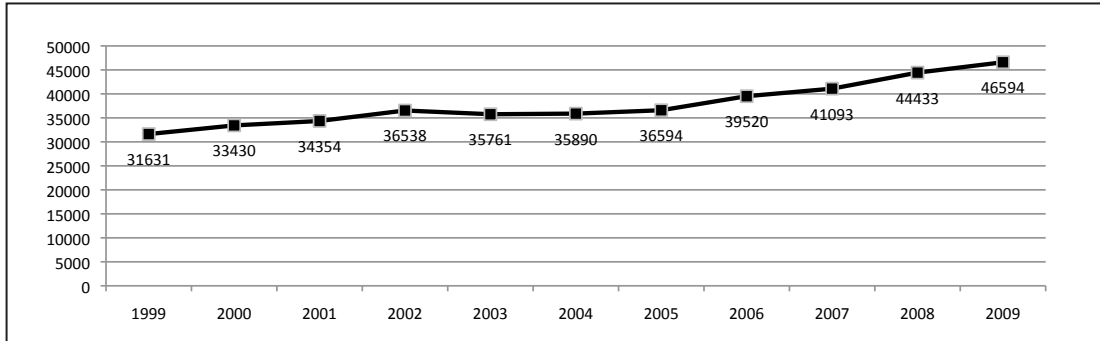

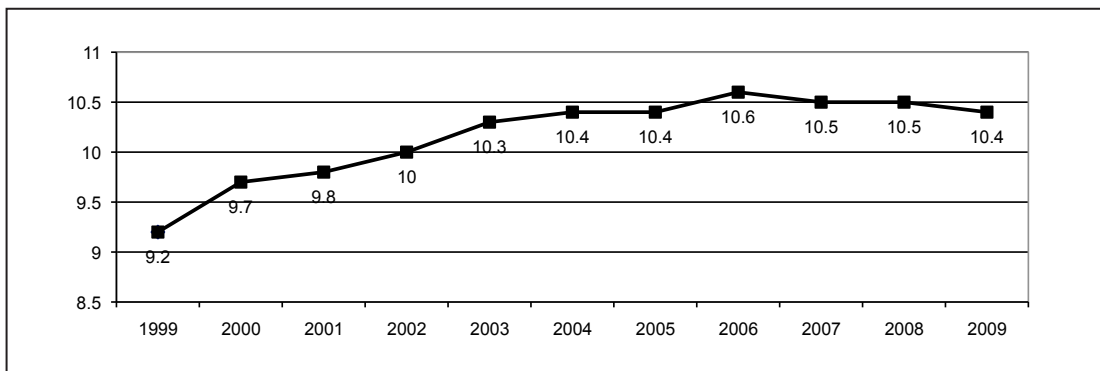

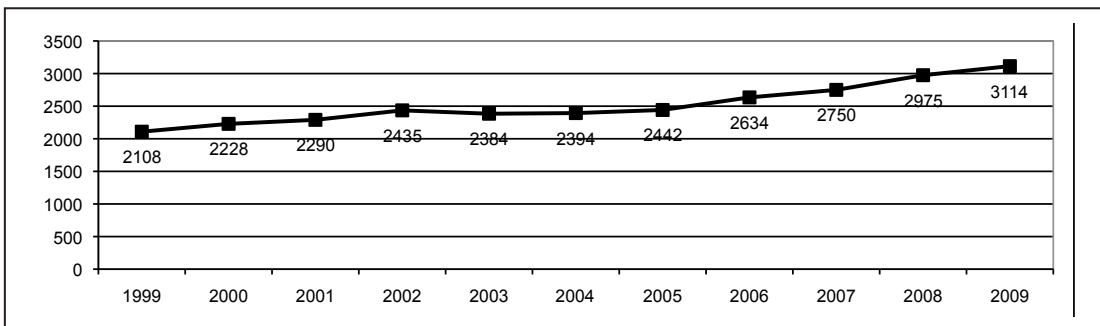
Total Credit Hours 1999-2009



Mean Credit Hours 1999-2009

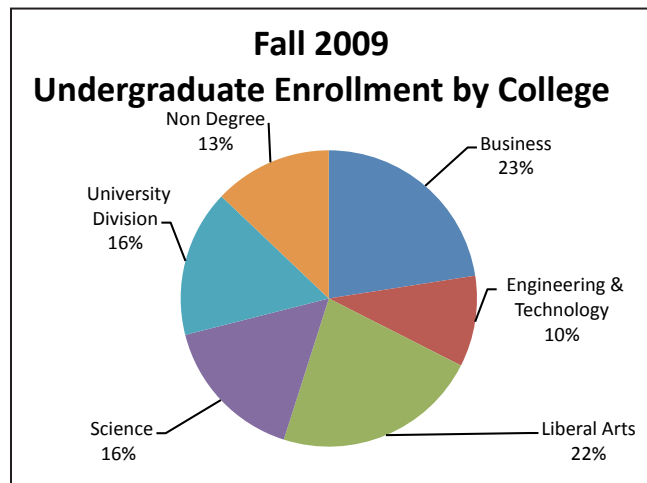


FTE Credit Hours 1999-2009
