

## **CLERY ACT CRIMES TO BE DISCLOSED ON PUBLIC PROPERTY LEASED BY PNC**

As required by federal law (Clery Act) and Purdue University Campus Security and Crime Statistics Policy (I.2.2), certain crimes must be reported on public property leased by PNC. For example, when PNC leases classroom space in a publicly owned high school on Tuesdays and Thursdays between the hours of 5:00pm and 10:00pm, we must disclose only and all Clery Act crimes that occurred in that space on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 5:00pm and 10:00pm. In addition, if there is additional space associated with the lease or rented space (e.g., stairwell, hallway or lobby that must be used to enter and leave the room), we must also disclose any reports of crimes occurring there during the time covered by our contracts. Also, when a publicly owned athletic stadium and associated parking spaces are leased by PNC for athletic games, we must report crimes that occurred during the time the facility is used by our students.

Clery crimes that should be reported are:

- Murder and non-negligent manslaughter
- Negligent manslaughter
- Forcible sex offenses
- Non-forcible sex offenses
- Robbery
- Aggravated assault
- Burglary
- Motor vehicle theft
- Arson
- All hate crimes involving bodily injury
- All liquor, drug or weapons law violations resulting in an arrest

If one of the above crimes, or any crime occurs, have the victim report the crime immediately to the police department having jurisdiction where the crime took place. In addition to reporting the crime to the local police, report all Clery Crimes to the PNC Campus Police, Chief of Police, 1401 S. US 421, Westville, IN 46391, 219-785-5220.
