Administrative Memorandum No. 10-2005

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The athletic department at Purdue University North Central wishes to award athletic scholarships in accordance with the policies and procedures of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), of which PNC is a member. To facilitate this goal while maintaining adequate institutional oversight for this scholarship program, the following policies and procedures shall be effective beginning with student athletes enrolled in the fall 2006 term and thereafter.

1. Athletic scholarships may only be awarded up to the amount of money budgeted for that purpose in the PNC annual budget. That amount shall not exceed the amount of money raised for athletic scholarships during the preceding year. Athletic scholarship money will appear as one or more line item(s) in the budget of the Financial Aid Office.
2. All athletic scholarships will be awarded in strict compliance with University and PNC policies. In keeping with Article II, Section B, of the NAIA regulations governing financial aid, all scholarships shall be “controlled by the faculty through the regularly constituted committee on student loans and scholarships.” At PNC that committee is currently chaired by the Vice Chancellor for Advancement. Individual student eligibility for funding shall be determined by the Director of Financial Aid.
3. In keeping with Title IX guidelines and requirements, athletic scholarships will be distributed equitably between men’s and women’s intercollegiate athletic teams and student athletes.
