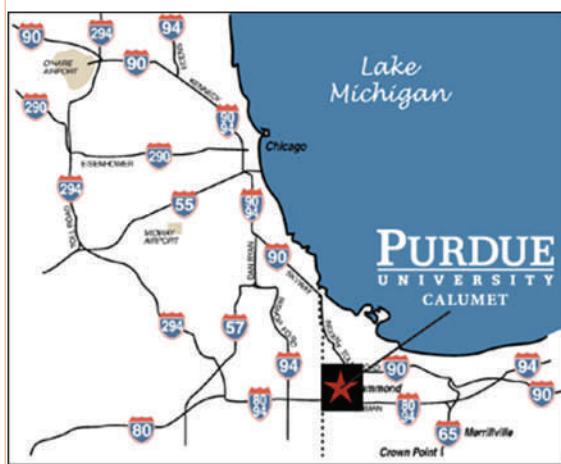

Our 14-building, 9,600+-student neighborhood campus is one-third mile north of Interstate 80/94 and three blocks east of Indianapolis Boulevard, accessible from 173rd and 169th Streets in Hammond, Indiana. Motorists may arrive at campus...

**From the west...**by traveling east on Interstate 80/94 to Indianapolis Boulevard; exit north and proceed one-third mile to 173rd Street; turn right/east and proceed three blocks to campus.

**From the east...**by traveling west on Interstate 80/94 to Kennedy Avenue; exit north and proceed one-third mile to 173rd Street; turn left/west and proceed approximately 3/4-mile to campus. You will turn tight at

**From the north side (Chicago area)...** by traveling south on Toll Road 294 to Interstate 80/94; proceed east and follow directions "from the west." OR, south on Interstate 94 through Chicago to Interstate 90 (Chicago Skyway); proceed south to Indianapolis Blvd/US41; continue southeast on Indianapolis Blvd approximately 8 miles 173rd Street; turn left/east and proceed three blocks to campus.

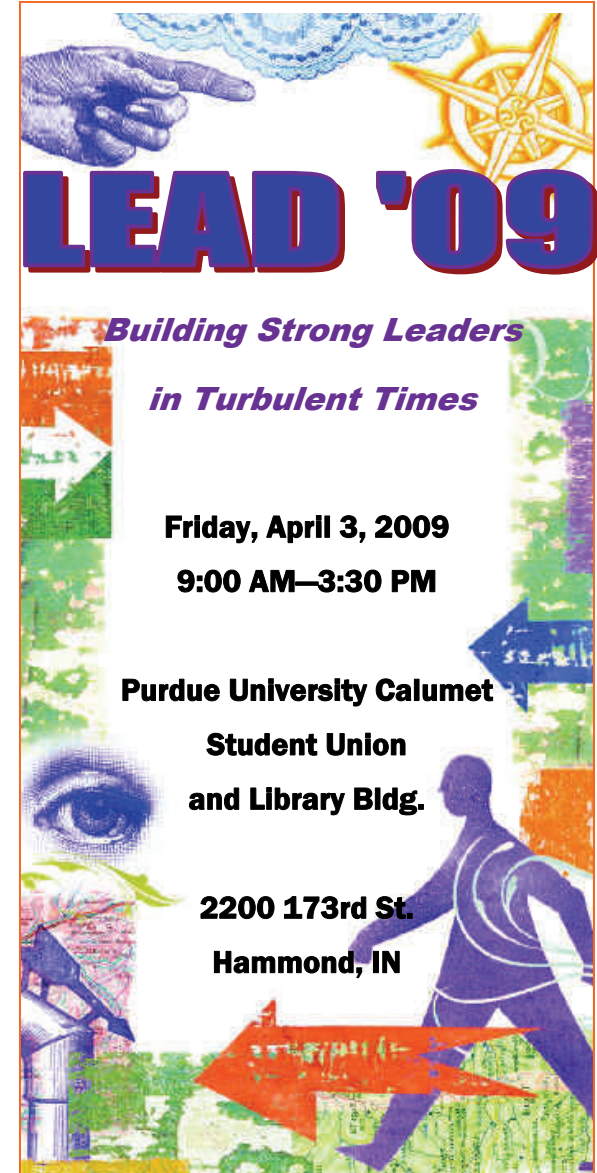
**From the south...**by traveling north on Interstate 65 to Interstate 80/94; proceed west to Kennedy Avenue; exit north and follow directions "from the east." OR, north on Highway U.S. 41/Indianapolis Boulevard to 173rd Street turn right/east and proceed three blocks to campus.
