

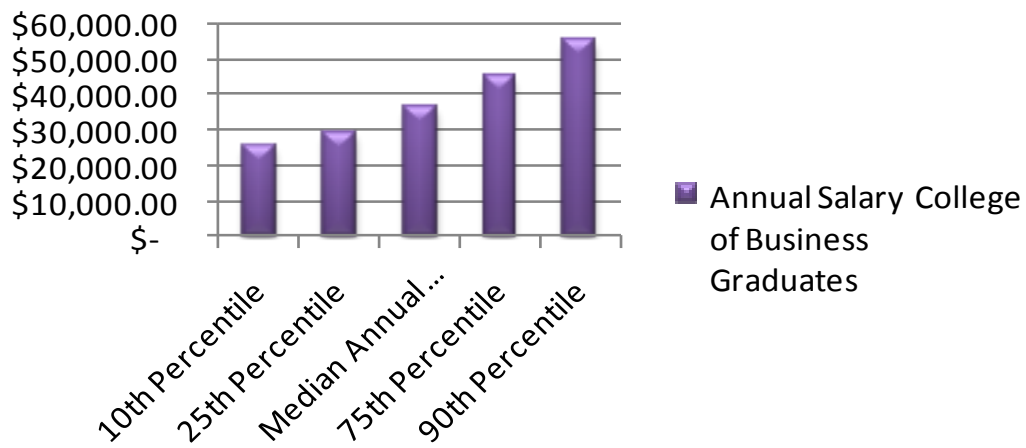
College of Business
