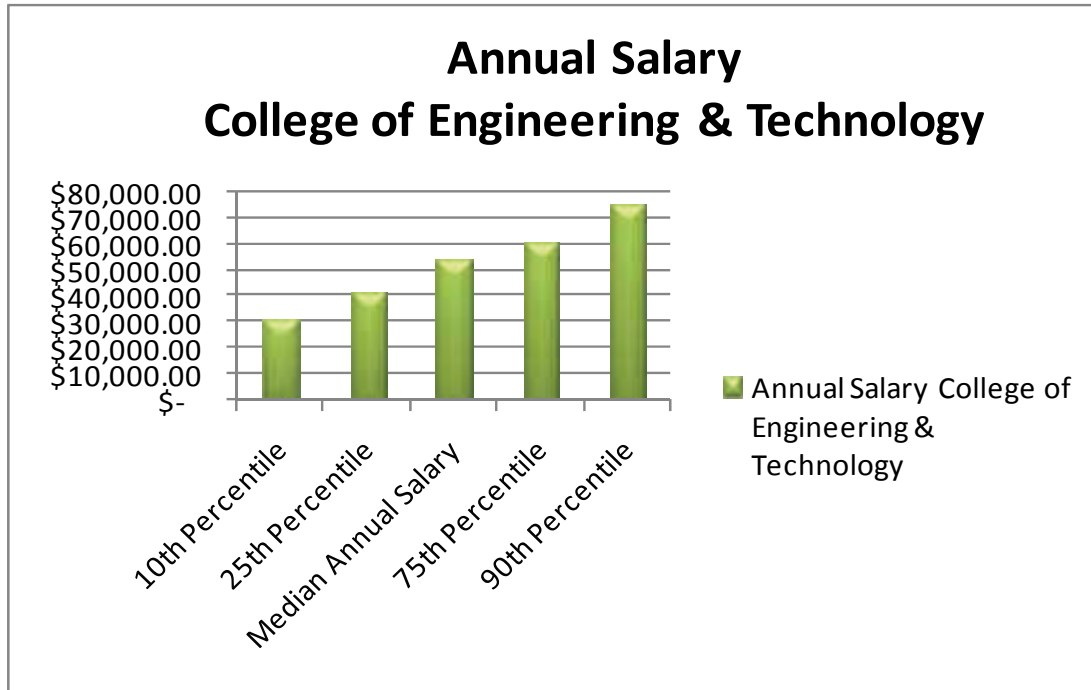


College of Engineering & Technology
