

# Update in Requirements for Education Programs At Purdue University North Central

## For All Programs

- Teacher Education Application – **MUST BE SUBMITTED**
  - Available September 1, 2010 via Education Department website at [www.pnc.edu/ed](http://www.pnc.edu/ed) under “Department Links” or by email from Bianca Villarruel at [bvillarr@pnc.edu](mailto:bvillarr@pnc.edu) or Dee Combs at [dcombs@pnc.edu](mailto:dcombs@pnc.edu)
  - Due in the Education Office (TECH 205) by May 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall admission and October 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring Admission
  - Cannot be submitted electronically
- Successful completion of *all three sections* of PRAXIS I
  - *Official passing scores* are due in the Education Office (TECH 205) by August 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall admission and December 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring Admission
- Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 or above

## Elementary Education Program

- Official approval for program admission must be granted before enrolling in Block I courses (EDCI 205 and EDCI 285).
- Successful completion with a grade of “C” or better in BIO 205, ENG 101 and MA 137, and *any* Education courses completed.

## Early Childhood Education Program

- Official approval for program admission must be granted before enrolling in Strand II courses (EDPS 236 and EDPS 276).
- Successful completion with a grade of “C” or better in BIO 205, ENG 101, MA 137, PSY 235, EDST 270, EDCI 276 and *any other* Education courses completed.

## Secondary Education Programs

- Official approval for program admission must be granted before enrolling in beginning Education courses (EDCI 205 and EDST 200).
- Successful completion with a grade of “C” or better in ENG 101, EDCI 105 and *any* Education courses completed.
