<p>APPLICATION TO PNC: Each student must FIRST complete an application for admission to Purdue North Central at the following link: Admissions - Purdue North Central. When this is done, the student will then utilize the following checklist to be sure everything is in order for admission to the Department of Nursing</p>	
<p>APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NURSING: Completed and signed application (Licensing questions must be answered.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applications for Fall semester are due by January 1 - Applications for Spring semester are due by August 1 <p>Nursing Programs available</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Associate of Science: select if you are seeking a program that will prepare you to take the licensure exam to become a Registered Nurse with an Associate Degree. This program is designed to be completed in two years. - Bachelor of Science: select if you are seeking a program that will prepare you to take the licensure exam to become a Registered Nurse with a Bachelor Degree. This program is designed to be completed in four years. 	
<p>TRANSCRIPT:</p> <p>High school students must submit high school transcripts.</p> <p>Students who have attended another college or university since their last enrollment at Purdue must request an official transcript to be sent to the Department of Nursing office.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Deadline for submission of a transcript for the Fall semester is January 15. - Deadline for submission of a transcript for the Spring semester is August 15. 	
<p>ADMISSION ASSESSMENT EXAM:</p> <p>All students (excluding RN/BS students) are required to complete an Admission Assessment Exam as part of the admission process to the Department of Nursing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Admission Assessment Exam fee must be paid for in the PNC Bursar's office. - The receipt for the Admission Assessment Exam must be provided to the Department of Nursing secretary, in person or via fax, in order for the student to schedule a time to take the exam. - Seating at each Admission Assessment Exam session is limited; reservations will be taken on a first come first served basis. - A schedule of the dates and times the Admission Assessment Exam will be given is available on the PNC Department of Nursing web site Department of Nursing - Purdue North Central "Admission Assessment Exam Schedule".
