4. Natural Sciences (6 hours)

Students must earn three credits in one of the following lab sciences: BIOL 121/122, BIOL 213 or 214; CHM 103, 111, 115, or 116; ASTR 263 or 264

Students must earn three credits in a non-lab science: EAS 120; F&N 303

Others may be acceptable; check with your advisor

NOTE: BIOL 211 and 212 have been approved for our campus as lab sciences

5. Concept Development (12 hours)

Students must choose either a mixture of computers/statistics or foreign language (not foreign literature)

6. Western Heritage/Social Ethics/Individual & Society (9 hours)

Students MUST complete IDIS 435 and IDIS 436 and choose one from the following: HIST 102, 103, 104; PHIL 110, 331; ENGL 262, 264, 266; PSY 120, 200, 235, 240, 250, 251, 370, 372; SOC 100, 220, 340; ECON 210

Others may be acceptable; check with your advisor

11. Gender Issues (3 hours)

IDIS 280; PSY 239, 365; ENGL 360; IDIS 490 Native American Women's Literature; FLL 490 Latin American Women Writers; GBG 490; COM 376; IDIS 590 Men, Women, and Madness; PSY 392 Psych of Men (approved for North Central only); ANTH 303
