### Sample Question

You are preparing to ambulate a patient down the hallway utilizing a gait belt. The proper position for you to assume while ambulating the patient is:

- a. While keeping your right hand on the gait belt, walk slightly ahead of the patient.
- b. Ensure lateral alignment of yourself & the patient so that you can walk together.
- c. Grasp the belt at the patient's back & walk behind and slightly to one side of the patient.
- d. Walk beside the patient only using the gait belt if the patient begins to fall.
