The La Verne Noyes Scholarship is awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need. Financial need is determined by the analysis of the income and asset information reported on the FAFSA. Applicants who do not demonstrate financial need will not be awarded the scholarship. All applicants will be notified in writing about the outcome of the scholarship selection.

The La Verne Noyes Scholarship is intended to assist in the payment of the student's tuition and fees. If the tuition and fees are being paid by another source, the scholarship will not be offered to the student.
