Description:

The Student Services Diversity Initiative Mini-Grant is a grant of up to \$300 awarded to a recognized student club(s) or organization(s). The award's primary goal is to support student group leadership and initiative toward contributing to the campus' greater understanding, valuing and appreciation of diversity.

Qualifications:

1. Be a recognized student club or organization on the Purdue University North Central Campus.
2. Be active in status.

Application Process:

1. Submit a plan outlining the proposed activity or activities, including the cost of the proposed activity and any resources or support needed from the campus administration/faculty in order to carry out the plan. The activity must be open to all PNC students. If the activity/programming is proposed to be open to the public, please indicate such in the plan. The plan must indicate the goal(s) and objective(s) of the activity and some measure of the intended outcome(s). The application must include a description of how the activity /program contribute to the campus's greater understanding, valuing and appreciation of diversity.
2. Submit a letter/statement of recommendation/support obtained from the club/organization advisor(s) and one other university faculty member or administrator.
3. A brief summary report of the activity, including the measured outcome must be submitted within three weeks of completing the activity.

Award Process:

Completed applications may be submitted to the Committee for the Retention of a Diverse Student Body throughout the academic year. Preference will be given to applications received by the priority deadlines of Friday, October 7, 2011 for an award for the fall semester, and Friday, March 2, 2012 for an award for the spring semester. Awards will be made on a funds available basis. Clubs and organizations are welcome to apply for more than one mini-grant in an academic year, providing that the proposals are submitted one at a time, with subsequent proposals following successful completion of the preceding proposed activity/program and submission of the summary report. Feel free to be creative and have fun with this opportunity
